Dear All Saints' Family,

We are drawing near the end of this third celebration of Juneteenth as a federal holiday. Maybe you had the day off. Maybe not. While I worked, from time to time throughout the day I kept thinking about freedom and what it means to be free in our society and on our planet today.

I also spent some time reading more about Juneteenth and listening to the ways people have been celebrating and remembering that day of freedom in Galveston, Texas in 1865. To me, one bit of advice on how to celebrate Juneteenth stands out. The advice was to read about why this holiday matters, attend an event, or go to an African American Museum. Through such activities, "Have that full human experience of seeing yourself in and through the eyes of others, even if that's not your own lived experience..."

I came across this prayer for Juneteenth and pass it along to you this evening (from the Episcopal Diocese of Los Angeles).

Almighty God, you rescued your people from slavery in Egypt, and throughout the ages you have never failed to hear the cries of the captives. We remember before you our siblings in Galveston, Texas who on June 19, 1865 received the glad tidings of their emancipation. Forgive us for the many grave sins that delayed that liberating word and have quieted it in the many years since. Anoint us with your Spirit to bring good news to the poor, to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim the year of your favor; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.


